Church Partnership:

Church partners provide a vital role in the construction of Habitat homes. The most important benefits to HFH of Marion County are the many prayers, volunteers, donations, and use of facilities that are critical to build a home in just a few months. Of course, there are benefits to our churches and volunteers as well. Among these benefits are missions outreach, discipleship, community outreach, meeting new people, and learning new skills and trades. HFH of Marion County has been fortunate to partner with many churches throughout our area in previous years and looks forward to partnering with new churches, organizations, and individuals as well. Family Selection:

For a family to qualify for a house they have to meet three criteria:

- 1) The prospective Partner Family must be living in **inadequate shelter**. There are a whole range of things that classify need – for more information please phone or email. The prospective Partner Family with the greatest need will have a house built for them, assuming they meet the next two criteria.
- 2) The prospective Partner Family must have the **ability to pay**. Again, the house is not given to the homeowner; they have to be able to pay back the loan. So, they have to have some source of income. The loan is provided to the family through Habitat, not a bank, but the family can default on the loan if they can't pay.
- 3) Partnership – The family also has to put in "**sweat equity**" – in other words they have to work 300 hours to build their own home. This is a very important item. Family members and friends can also help to accomplish some of the sweat equity hours.
